

Greenwich and Lewisham Twins Club Nearly New Sale (NNS) Information

This document aims to provide guidance and information to ensure the NNS is a success – for both buyers and sellers. It also contains instructions for sellers.

Please note that by entering your goods into the sale you are indicating that you have read, understood and accepted these instructions.

Buyers and sellers please be aware that Greenwich and Lewisham Twins Club are not responsible for any goods bought or sold at the sale. Use a common sense approach when deciding on what to sell or buy, particularly with regard to items such as electrical equipment, scooter/bicycle helmets, car seats etc. Greenwich and Lewisham Twin Club cannot guarantee the safety of such items.

All monies raised from the NNS go towards continuing the services and support offered to local families by the Greenwich and Lewisham Twins Club.

General information and instructions for sellers:

- A table costs £20 to hire.
- Tables will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- Payment must be made in full at least a week before the sale vis BACS transfer.

- If you wish to cancel your table booking please email us as soon as possible. If you cancel more than more than a week before the sale and have already made your payment a full refund will be made. If you cancel less than a week before the sale you will not receive a refund.
- The table size is approximately 180cm x 75cm. You may also make use of the space under the table, as long as you do not obstruct the aisles. If you would like to bring a small clothes rail to place alongside your table please let us know in advance so we can ensure you have the space you need. If you are planning to sell any large items such as buggies, cots, bouncer chairs etc. please also advise us of this prior to the sale.
- Please remember to bring: a float, plastic bags for your customers purchases and anything you will need to label, present and organise your items. Please note we do not provide table cloths for the tables.
- Tips for success: make sure all your items are in good condition, clothing sells better if it is appropriate for the coming season, good categorization and presentation may help you sell more items and remember to price realistically. Do not overprice items. Please bear in mind that smaller items of childrens clothing (vests, socks etc) can be bought very cheaply and brand new from supermarkets.
- We are unable to provide you with somewhere to store valuables so please ensure you keep all property with you on the day.

Information for the day of the sale (sellers):

- There is a carpark attached to the hall which holds a capacity of approximately 15-20 vehicles.
- When you arrive please make yourself known to a Twins Club volunteer. Check the plan displayed to find your table.
- The sale will be open to the public from 2-4pm. You may arrive from 1pm onwards to set up your table. You will have until 4.45pm after the sale to clear your area and load your car with any unsold items. Please take any rubbish with you, leaving your table/area in a tidy condition at the end of the sale.

Information for the day of the sale (buyers):

- There is a carpark attached to the hall but bear in mind that sellers are likely to have taken most of the spaces before the sale begins so be prepared to park on nearby streets.
- There is a £1 charge per adult to attend the sale. Entry for children is free.
- There will be tea, coffee and cake for sale.
- There are toilets available for use in the hall (including access to a disabled toilet and baby changing facilities).
